## LAS VEGAS "SIN CITY RENDEZVOUS 2003" TENTATIVE SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

We'll start off the festivities on Friday evening beginning around 4:00 PM at the [Speedway Casino](#) in North Las Vegas. We'll meet in the parking lot and mingle until around 5:00, then go inside to register, draw for door prizes, and discuss plans for Saturday. We'll have our own area set aside in the casino, near the restaurant and bar. The 300M Enthusiasts Club will provide pitchers of beer and soda, and the Casino will provide us with some snacks and munchies.

To get to the Speedway Casino from the Las Vegas Strip, take any of the East-West streets (Tropicana, Flamingo, Desert Inn, Sahara) West a short distance to I-15. Go north on I-15 for about 7 miles and exit at Cheyenne Road. The Speedway Casino is on the northeast corner of I-15 and Cheyenne. You can't miss the sign when you exit at Cheyenne.

The Speedway Casino has a Ramada Inn right next door (actually attached), so anyone who doesn't care to pay the high "Strip" hotel prices, might consider staying there. The link above also has some discount coupons for lodging and food, so print out your coupons and bring them along.

When we're ready (probably around 6:00) anyone who is still hungry can go in to Rookies Restaurant, right next door, for burgers, steaks, or whatever. You'll be ordering from their menu, which is pretty decent and reasonably priced.

When we're done at the Speedway Casino, anyone who wants to continue partying can cruise a short 2 miles to the [Cannery Casino Welcome Party](#) and continue until 9:00 PM (or probably later). The Cannery Casino is brand new and will be hosting this event in their outdoor courtyard. There will be many Mopar exhibits and live entertainment.

On Saturday Morning, it's back to the Speedway Casino at 9:00 AM for breakfast (if you like) and to hold our own 300M Club car show and judging in the parking lot. Trophies will be awarded in four categories as follows:

"Most Custom" – Interior, exterior and/or performance

"Most Clean" – Clean and Polished, stock or near stock

"Most Classy" – All around cool and buff

"Most Cruisin'" – Greatest distance traveled to get to the event (distance actually driven, not counting flying miles)

We'll need three members who don't want to enter their cars in the contest, to serve as judges. The Rand-McNally Atlas will be the final authority on the Most Cruisin' trophy.

After that, we'll cruise the short distance (5 miles) to the [Las Vegas Motor Speedway](#) for the [Mopars at the Strip](#) events (car shows, swap meet, etc. If you want to participate in any of the Mopars at the Strip events (other than swap meet, etc) you need to register with them by March 21<sup>st</sup>. Details and times on all the events are on their site, along with registration forms.

After the Saturday festivities at Las Vegas Motor Speedway, anyone who wants to continue can again Cruise to the Cannery Casino for another evening of the [Mopars at the Strip Welcome Party](#). The Cannery has several restaurants and a good buffet restaurant. Vegas is renowned for it's sumptuous buffets, so bring an appetite if you opt for the dinner buffet.

Sunday morning, we'll probably meet (if anyone is still standing) at a Strip restaurant to have a Las Vegas style breakfast and say our good-byes.

Since this is Las Vegas, some of you may want to forego some of the Mopars events and spend more time on the Las Vegas Strip. There's more than you can possibly see in one day. There is also shopping for the ladies right on the Strip at the [Fashion Show Mall](#), featuring Saks Fifth Avenue, Neiman Marcus, Nordstrom, and too many others to list.

One CAUTION if you haven't driven in Nevada before. U-Turns are LEGAL in Nevada, unless otherwise marked. Don't be surprised when you see people doing U-Turns in the middle of the intersection. This causes a lot of accidents here, so PLEASE be careful and don't become a statistic.
